2021-2022 COVID HEALTH & SAFETY GUIDELINES



Continue to maintain social distancing in all school settings as much as possible.



Properly fitted masks are RECOMMENDED



Buses and buildings will be properly cleaned and regularly sanitized.



Students who are Covid positive will isolate at home for 10 days from onset of symptoms. Symptomatic students will be sent home on a case-by-case basis.

REMEMBER

Hygiene measures, physical distancing, good hand-washing practices, and symptom monitoring are still very strongly encouraged and necessary to maintain a lower risk of infection.

Any decision regarding schools moving to a remote platform, virtual platform, or closing completely will be made by the Superintendent and the Covid Team on a case-by-case basis.
