Colbert County Schools Board Meeting May 20, 2021

The Colbert County Board of Education met on May 20, 2021 at the office of the Superintendent. The time of the meeting was 5:00 p.m. All members were present except Thomas Burgess. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and an invocation was held.
